FAQ --- POFPS Bring a Member Program

> What is the POFPS Bring A Member Program?

A current POFPS member who recruits a new member during the 2020 calendar year will qualify for a 20 percent discount on their 2021 dues.

What is the definition of a new member?

A new member is an osteopathic physician who has not been a member of the POFPS since 2017 or longer

How do a report/document a new member?

You may report the recruited new member on the back of the dues invoice form or download the separate report form from the website. Please complete the form and return back the POFPS via fax or email. You may also complete the online form.

What information is required on recruited member?

Please use the form provided to give us the name and contact information for the colleague you are recruiting.

How many new members can I recruit?

A POFPS member can recruit up to 5 new members for the 2020 dues period

What is the deadline to recruit new members?

New members need to be recruited and paid in full by March 31, 2020

What is the discount?

You will receive a 20% discount for each new member recruited and the discount(s) will be applied to your 2021 dues. One 20% discount is equal to \$22.00 (20% of \$110.00 – POFPS 2020 dues).

When will I receive the discount?

The discounted rate will be applied to the POFPS 2021 dues calendar year.

- What is the verification process for recruited candidates? The POFPS staff will research the recruited member and verify that they meet the new member criteria.
- How will I know if I qualify for a discount rate in 2021? If the recruited member meets the criteria and pays his or her 2020 dues, the member will be informed that they will have a discounted rate in 2021.

How is the discounted rate applied?

The 2021 invoice you will receive or pay online will have the discount already applied and you will pay the balance due on the invoice.
